Poster Requirements - Materials:

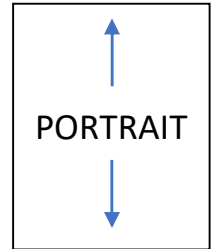

Size and Layout:

Minimum: 8 ½" x 11" Maximum: 18" x 24"

Portrait / vertical layout only!!

(Any weight paper is acceptable, but poster board would be ideal.)



Submitting and Judging:

Please submit your poster to Ms. DiGioia (CTMS art teacher) no later than **Thursday, February 21**. Please write your name on the back of your poster. Only one poster per student! Entries will be judged by the Penny Auction Committee, and winners will be notified.

Awards:

One winner will receive a Penny Auction admission bracelet and combo package of tickets (including general prize, grand prize and super grand prize tickets). Honorable mention will be awarded as well with an admission bracelet and general prize ticket packet.
