ITEMS TO NOTE

April Meeting Review

The Clinton Township Board of Education has three standing committees. They are Facilities and Finance, Personnel, and Policy and Curriculum. Below you will find the highlights of each committee report from the April 2018 Board meeting.

Superintendent's Report

- April enrollment is 1,273 students.
- Dr. Fiander reported on QSAC evaluation.

Annual Budget Hearing Presentation

- Dr. Fiander presented the Final 2018-2019 Budget to the full Board.
- The Board approved the [Final 2018-2019 Budget](#) by a vote of 7-0.

Facilities and Finance Committee

- Authorized payment of bills for \$2,501,598.97.
- Approved seven staff members to attend professional development conferences.
- Accepted the request for graduate course work for six staff members.

Personnel Committee

- Accepted, with regret, the retirement of Diane Hanley, Payroll Coordinator, and Heather Steinhauer, PMG Second Grade Teacher.

- Approved maternity leave and disability leaves of absence requests.
- Approved job description [A-12.1- Accounts Payable Coordinator/Administrative Assistant](#).

Policy and Curriculum Committee

- Approved the [NJCAP](#) Grant Application.
- Accepted the second reading and adoption of [Policy: 2431.1 - Athletic Teams – Team Size Guidelines](#).

Negotiations Update

- A new mediator was assigned on March 19, 2018, after the first mediator was found to have a conflict of interest in this negotiation.
- A newly assigned mediator provided the Board and CTEA with three potential dates for both parties to begin mediation.
- Both parties were not available for any of the proposed dates, as confirmed in a letter written by the mediator dated April 3, 2018.
- Three new, potential mediation dates were provided to both parties. Both parties agree to meet on May 10th to begin mediation.

Special Meeting

- The Board of Education will hold a special meeting on Thursday, May 31, 2018 at 7:30 p.m. in the Clinton Township Middle School auditorium.
- During the special meeting, the ad hoc committee that has been reviewing the feasibility of closing a school will provide its report and make a recommendation.
- The full Board will vote to either approve or reject the committee's recommendation.
