ITEMS TO NOTE

January Meeting Review

The Clinton Township Board of Education has three standing committees. They are Facilities and Finance, Personnel, and Policy and Curriculum. Below you will find the highlights of each committee report from the January 2018 board meeting.

Superintendent's Report

- January Enrollment: 1,266

Facilities and Finance Committee

- Authorizes payment of bills for \$2,483,057.60.
- Approves employment travel for 18 employees to attend various professional development programs and two employees for graduate courses.
- Participates in coordinated transportation with Warren County Special Services School District for 2018-19 for special education, non-public, and public school routes.

Personnel Committee

- Accepts with regret, the July 1, 2018 retirement of Michel Beha, CTMS School Nurse and Ellen Jacobson, CTMS Teacher.
- Approves three maternity leave requests and six disability leave of absence requests.
- Approves spring coaches for baseball, softball, a golf advisor, and golf chaperones.

Policy and Curriculum Committee

- Authorizes the Bi-annual statement of assurance for Paraprofessional Staff for 2017-18.
- Approves a field trip to the Hunterdon County Library for Ms. Nish/Ms. Fuentes' class.

Board Governance Facts

- The Board of Education is comprised of nine elected members.
- The full Board of Education meets once per month, usually on the last Monday of each month.
- The Board elects a president and vice president at the reorganization meeting, held during the first week of January.
- The president assigns members of the board to serve on specific regular and ad hoc committees.
- Members of the Board also serve as liaisons to the Hunterdon County School Board, Hunterdon County Educational Services Commission, and the New Jersey School Board Association Delegation.
- The Board president and vice president represent the Clinton Township Board of Education at all North Hunterdon Voorhees School District Round Table Meetings.
