On January 8, 2017, the Clinton Township Board of Education held its reorganization meeting. At that meeting, the Board welcomed four newly elected members, and welcomed back five returning members. The Board then elected both a president and vice president to lead during 2018-19. The Board President assigned members to the standing committees, including: Facilities and Finance, Policy and Curriculum, Personnel and Negotiations. In addition, Board members serves as liaisons to the Hunterdon County School Board, Hunterdon County Educational Services Commission, and the New Jersey School Board Association Delegation.
