MEMORANDUM

Re: Annual Re-Notification Required by AHERA-Asbestos
Annual Re-Notification Required by P. L. 1998, c364 – Hazardous Substance

The Clinton Township Board of Education in accordance with The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) 40 CFR 763 requires all schools housing students in preschool through grade 12 to undergo inspections to determine the presence of Asbestos Containing Building Material (ACBM). If found, ACBM must be categorized according to the type of material, location, current damage/condition, and potential for future damage. School districts must keep on file a detailed Asbestos Management Plan. The Management Plan details the inspection findings and outlines the response actions the School Board intends to implement.

To accomplish these goals, the Clinton Township Board of Education has on file at Round Valley School, Spruce Run School, and the District Office a NJ State Department of Health approved Asbestos Management Plan for school facilities. The provisions provided within the Asbestos Management Plan are implemented and maintained in a timely and ongoing fashion. The Board of Education will ensure that a three-year re-inspection is scheduled and performed and will continue with scheduled six-month periodic surveillances as required by the AHERA regulations. It is the Clinton Township Board of Education's desire to provide a safe and healthy facility for all students, staff, and visitors.

The purpose of this memorandum is to satisfy the requirements under AHERA for written notice of the availability of the Asbestos Management Plan for review. Since the last written notice the following actions have been completed:

- July 2013 – Round Valley School, floor tile (room 4) and mastic were removed for renovation purposes. Air sampling was conducted and the air was certified as clean.
- August 2014 – The three-year re-inspection under AHERA was conducted for Round Valley School and Spruce Run School. The next three year re-inspection is scheduled for August of 2017.
- June 2016 – Removal of floor tile and mastic for upgrades at Spruce Run School (rooms 101, 102, 106, 107, 108, 109, 110, 111, and 112). Air sampling was conducted and all rooms in the above were certified with clean air.
- November 2016 – The required six-month surveillance was conducted and performed at Round Valley School and Spruce Run School.
