

Evaluation Team Report Competitive Contracting RFP #24-01 Tutoring Services

Potential vendors submitting proposals for RFP #24-01:

- Sunshine Education
- New Jersey Tutoring Corps

The two responses were reviewed and scored by an evaluation team including the Director of Curriculum, Learning, and Grants, a building principal, the School Business Administrator, and an instructional staff representative.

Ranking:

Rationale: The evaluation team spent about 90 minutes considering both proposals; minimum requirements as set forth in RFP #24-01 were considered, and criteria and weights for technical, management, and cost parameters as outlined in RFP #24-01 were used to score submitted proposals. New Jersey Tutoring Corps' proposal was ranked higher than Sunshine Education's proposal by all scorers across technical and management criteria as outlined in RFP #24-01. Both fee proposals were clear and precise, and each garnered a full 6 points by all scorers. Cost calculations provided by New Jersey Tutoring Corps were approximately 37% less than those provided by Sunshine Education.

Recommendation: The evaluation team recommends the award of RFP #24-01 to New Jersey Tutoring Corps as their proposal was most advantageous to the district, price and other factors considered.
